ENJOYING THE WARMTH!



Language Arts

The Kindergarten students continued with more phonics rules and sounds, especially the q, v, x, and z, learned both plural and possessive use of the letter S and the "sh" sound. We also read a story called *In a Camel's Eye*. First grade continued to read and practice spelling. We are adding a new spelling list each week. Please remember to review at home. This week we added "tion" and "sion" to our list of phonics rules. The students are also learning a new poem by Robert Louis Stevenson. We reviewed nouns, pronouns, and verbs this week as well as learning how to use commas in an address and commas in a list.

Math

Our Kindergarten class is working diligently

IMPORTANT RE-ENROLLMENT INFORMATION

We are thrilled that Mebane now has its own Christian and Classical school. It has been exciting to take this step of faith together! We have joined the renaissance of true education. As we make plans to build our program, we need our current families to begin the process of re-enrollment. Please watch for the **RE-ENROLLMENT** form that will be coming home next week. Our policy indicates that a non-refundable \$500 contract deposit is due in March. This deadline is included to guarantee a spot if in the future we have more applicants than spots available. Since this is presently not the case, you may elect to make the deposit at a later time **on or before June 1st, 2009.**

If you intend to apply for financial aid for next year, you may begin that process as soon as you have your '08 tax information. We have again contracted with FFNA as a third party financial needs assessor. The details for our tuition policy and how to apply for financial assistance can be found online. Please review this policy and contact me if you have any questions. Remember the *Lump Sum Discount* is available until June 1st, 2009.



SPECIAL NOTE FROM THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

In an effort to encourage early application, the Board has resolved to waive the application fee for all new students if the application is received (or postmarked) on or before March 31st, 2009. This applies only to applications for the 2009/2010 school year. We hope to encourage as many families as are interested to apply early so we can make the best decisions moving forward.

FUTURE PLANS: There has been some interest in adding additional grades beyond our original plan. We are presently discussing the possibility of adding a Pre-K program and a 3rd/4th grade class. Both of these projects will require a number of additional students. Please pray for wisdom as we investigate these possibilities.
