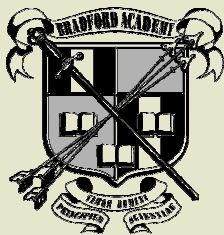

Use the attached handwriting sheets to practice and improve this vital skill. Don't forget that we use D'Nealian manuscript.



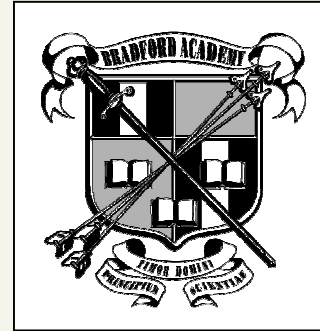
