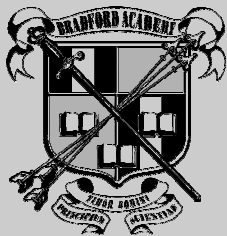

- 1st - adding two digit numbers, and reviewed measuring, counting nickels, writing date using digits, sums of 12

History:

- 1st/2nd - NC history, 20th Century. This week we talked about World War II.

P.E.:

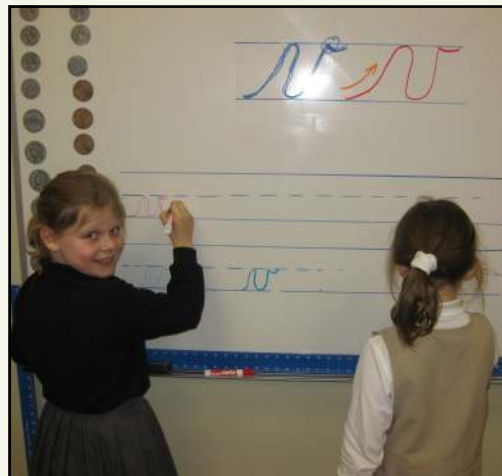
- Continued to practice galloping, leaping, jumping, and hopping in the "Cowboy Station" (galloping), Leaping Station, and Jumping Station
