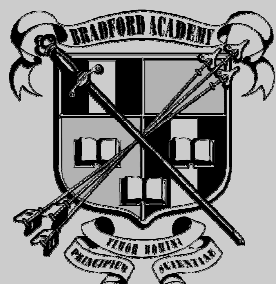

Language Arts:

- 2nd - The 2nd graders have now completed all the lower case letters in cursive! Soon we'll make the switch! We also worked on sight words this week.
- 1st - We read *Lexi's Hope*, continued vowel digraphs, manuscript practice, and parts of speech

Math:

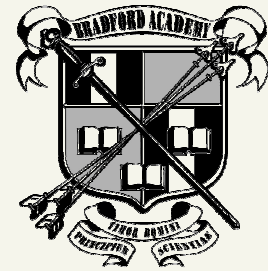
- 2nd - continued to review base ten blocks, division, difference in multiples of 10, 10 and 7 times tables, and squaring a number
- 1st - adding two digit numbers, and reviewed measuring, counting nickels, writing date using digits, sums of 12

History:

- K - This week we continued to look at the beginnings of the Church, the life of Paul and early persecutions. We also discussed the destruction of the Temple in 70AD. The students continue to stay very excited about our study of the Romans!
- 1st/2nd - NC history, 20th Century. This week we talked about conclusion of World War II and the beginnings of the Cold War.

Science:

- 1st/2nd - We continued our study of birds of North America. Be sure to ask your child about the bird sound-off.
- K - Began a discussion of volcanoes with an introduction to Mt. Vesuvius and the destruction of Pompeii in 79AD.

P.E.

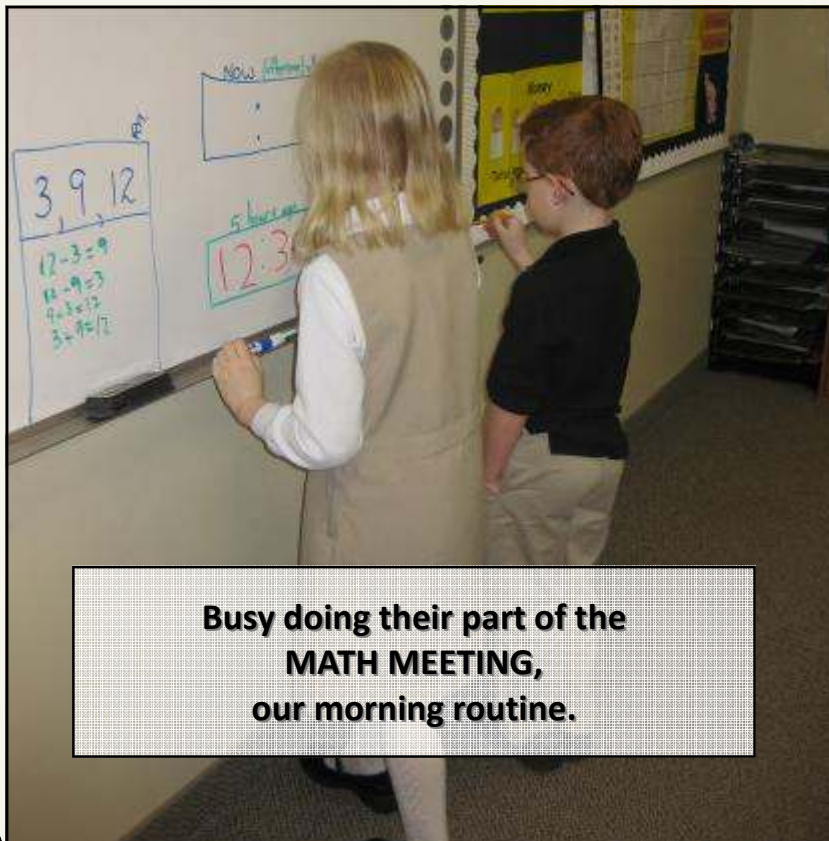
- Students learned what two parts make up a skip (a step and a hop) and practiced skipping
