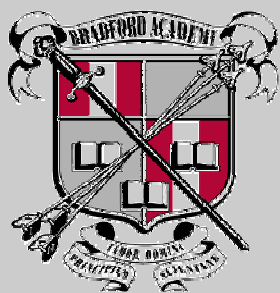

Language Arts:

- 2nd - Reviewed vowel digraphs, stable final syllables, and combination letters. We also studied the use of y as a vowel. We began our literature packets this week focusing on reading comprehension.
- 3rd - Students continued their look at the ancient Greek Myths using D'Aulaires wonderful retelling of the myths.

Math:

- 2nd - 9 Facts, writing money as dollars and cents, counting tally marks, 5 and 6 facts, and mental computation.
- 3rd - quick facts and mental computation of 3 digit sums, fractions, pie graphs, measuring with sixteenths of an inch, and multiplying two digits.

K/1st History: We reviewed the rise of Roman power. 1st grade continued to learn the presidents. We also discussed the Spanish American War and the many blessings

of the 19th century. We especially focused on the ingenuity of America in its infancy.

2nd/3rd History: Discussed the various prophets of God that were prominent during the final years of the old covenant canon.

2nd & 3rd Grade Latin: 2nd grade continued learning names of school and household items while 3rd spent the week in review.
